Once a rural ranching and recreational locale adjacent to the Olinda oil field, the county's first, it has encountered the encroaching forces of suburbanization in recent decades and faces a contested future. Local historian, Paul Spitzzeri will overview the fascinating and diverse history of this unique corner of Orange County including a display of historic artifacts relating to the canyon. 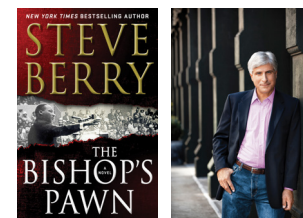
