



We propose to furnish and install all labor, materials and equipment as listed below for the upgrade of existing Women's restroom to ADA compliant unisex restroom:

- Remove & dispose of existing: floor and wall tile, toilet partitions, entry door & frame, interior door & frame, alcove walls except existing through wall, demo wall adjacent to sinks, cap two toilet that will not be used anymore and demo interior wall board behind existing tile that was removed.
- Remove and save for reinstallation: mirror, toilet paper holders, toilet seat cover holder, feminine napkin vendor, trash/paper towel unit, soap dispensers, two toilets, two sinks, and exterior art work.
- Reinstall existing: mirror, toilet paper holder, toilet seat cover holder, feminine napkin vendor, trash/paper towel unit, soap dispenser, one toilet, reinstall existing sink to be ADA compliant height. ADA toilet will require flush valve handle to be rotated to the opposite side of the toilet. This can be done when the wall is opened up by moving the plumbing water line in the wall. The sink will require replacing the faucet with an ADA compliant faucet. Reinstall exterior art work.
- Install new: provide and install new green board on walls, new wall and floor tile (Dal-Tile group 1 pricing), new entry door & frame with oil rubbed bronze storeroom function Corbin Russwin unit lock, new door closer, new hinges, new ADA compliant signage, new kick plate, door & frame to match existing size and style to what was taken out, new rubber top set base at new area of outside wall, acoustical ceiling repair as required relocate electrical outlet, and painting as required.

• Plans will be provided and approved through the city & City permits. An allowance of \$1,500.00 for plan check and permit fees have been included. If cost is greater than this additional costs will be billed with no mark up. Surety bonds.

Thank you for inviting us to bid your project. In order to bring the Women's restroom up to compliance, we propose the following:

1. Remove the outer door and door frame, repair the drywall and paint,

2. Remove all of the plumbing fixtures, ceramic tile on walls and on floor, ceiling tile, stall partitions, and restroom accessories (salvage for re-use the soap dispensers, paper towel dispensers, etc.)

3. Demo a 4' section of wall as marked on the attached plan. Build a new wall to allow 18"

of clearance on the left side (slam side) of the door as required.

4. Saw-cut floor at toilet flange, and relocate so the center of the toilet is 18" from the finished wall surface, as required.

5. Remove and replace the latch-set on the existing door, and replace with a lever type, as

required.

6. Install a new Handicap toilet (required), a new sink and a new faucet with lever handles, as required.

7. Provide and install a new 24" x 36" mirror with brushed aluminum frame.

8. Provide and install 6" x 6" Dal Tile ceramic tile on the walls up to 4' above the finished floor. Install ceramic cove base, and slip resistant 8" x 8" tile floor, and grout.

9. Prime and paint remaining wall and ceiling.

10. In stall all existing restroom accessories and new grab bars.

Excluded: Permit fees, any city fees, and any environmental issues, prevailing wage, and overtime.

- > Remove and reinstall new hallway floor tile, I don't think you can match the existing tile, so you will need new tile that will butt up to the tile in the exterior space, and will never look good
- > Frame, drywall, tape, and insulate a new wall to widen hallway
- > Prime and paint the new wall
- Paint the outside of the wall in the open area, and hope the paint matches
- Reframe the ceiling when widening hallway
- > Remove and replace hallway ceiling tiles (can not match old tiles)







The Library Board of Trustees approved Resolution 10-02 for the Holiday and Library Closure Schedule at the June 16, 2009 Unusual Date Board meeting.

To conform with the approved Resolution 10-02, the Placentia Library District Policy #2030 - Holidays need to be revised.

Attachment A is the existing Policy #2030 - Holidays.

## POLICY HANDBOOK

POLICY TITLE: Holidays POLICY NUMBER: 2030

**2030.1** This policy will apply to all regular full-time and part-time employees who work twenty hours or more per week.

2030.2 The following days will be recognized and observed as paid holidays:

New Years Day
President's Day
Martin Luther King Day
Memorial Day
Independence Day
Labor Day
Veteran's Day
Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Eve Day
Christmas Day
New Year's Eve Day

New Year's Eve Day

2 Floating Holidays, one accrued in April and one accrued in October, each on the second pay period of the month.

2030.3 All regular work will be suspended and employees will receive one-day's pay for each of the holidays listed above. An employee is eligible for any paid holiday if he/she works the day before and the day after said holiday. Eligibility is also granted if the employee is on vacation or has notified his/her supervisor and the Library Director and received permission to be absent from work on that specific day or days.

**2030.4** Holiday hours are based on an eight hour day of a forty (40) hour work week. Employees working less than forty (40) hours per week will receive a pro-rata allocation of holiday hours.

2030.5 When a holiday falls on an employee's day off or when the Library is closed, the employee will request any day during the work week of the holiday, approved by his/her scheduling supervisor, to compensate for this holiday.

2030.6 When a holiday occurs on a Monday, the full-time and regular part-time staff will be subject to different work schedules for that work week so that each full-time and regular part-

time staff member will work at least one holiday weekend per year and receive at least two four-day weekends per year. The scheduling supervisors will strive to give each full-time and regular part-time staff member who works on a holiday weekend, two days off in succession during the week with the Monday holiday.

2030.7 Any employee who works on any of the holidays listed above, excluding floating holidays, will be paid for all hours worked at the rate of time and one-half (1½) the regular rate of pay, or as otherwise specified under Policy #2010, "Hours of Work and Overtime."
